Pima Association of Governments will provide an overview of its interactive water mapping tool, which has been developed as a community resource to support water planning by governments, non-profits and residents. These maps allow the user to combine and juxtapose such diverse items as wells, Water Accounting Areas, green infrastructure sites, stormwater flows and shallow groundwater areas. The interactive mapping tool has been used to introduce topics such as utilization of stormwater through green infrastructure and protection of shallow groundwater areas into water discussions that were previously focused almost entirely on large water provider municipal supplies and Active Management Area priorities.
