336-mile aqueduct from Lake Havasu to Tucson

14 pumping plants lift water uphill nearly 3,000'

Lake Pleasant/New Waddell Dam

CAP annually delivers approx.1.6 million AF (1 acre-foot = 325,851 gallons)

First delivery in 1985 in Maricopa County

Construction of the canal completed in 1993


